### **CLUB HISTORY**

Following the demise of Borough United in 1967, who were the Welsh representatives in the European Cup Winners' Cup in 1963/64, there was a void of Welsh League clubs in the Conwy area. Historically there has always been football in the area, and especially a Conwy team, stretching back to the 1870s. Then in 1977 Conwy Town and Conwy Royal British Legion, both of whom played in the Vale of Conwy League, amalgamated to form Conwy United.

The club was duly elected to the Welsh League (North) that later became the Welsh Alliance League. In 1981/82 the club won the Welsh Intermediate Cup (now called the FAW Welsh Trophy) and the club also won the Welsh Alliance League title in 1984/85 and 1985/86. In 1990 the club became founder members of the Cymru Alliance League and finished in the top seven both seasons that they were members.

Then in 1992 the club became founder members of the League of Wales. The club finished a creditable 7th place in its first season and in 1995/96 finished in 3rd place under the guidance of John Hulse, with Kenny McKenna setting a club scoring record of 49 goals in a season. The club qualified for the 1996 UEFA Intertoto Cup and played Charleroi (Belgium) and SV Ried (Austria) at the Racecourse Ground, Wrexham, and travelled to Zaglebie Lubin (Poland) and Silkeborg (Denmark). Despite not progressing past the group stage, the club gave a good account of itself especially with a 0-0 draw against Charleroi and losing to a late goal against SV Ried.

In the following three seasons the club reached the semi-finals of the Welsh Cup twice, and also qualified for the FAW Premier Cup twice, most notably holding Swansea City to 0-0 draw at the Vetch Field. However, the financial burden had begun to take its toll on the club and in 2000 were relegated.

The club decided not to progress to the Cymru Alliance for financial reasons and instead accepted an invitation to join the Welsh Alliance League. In its second season the club was League runners-up and Cookson Cup runners-up. The following two seasons were very difficult both on and off the field but the return of Nigel Roberts as manager kept the club up and the 2004-05 season started tremendously well with the club sitting

at the top of the League. However, tragedy struck when Nigel Roberts was killed in a road accident. The league slipped just out of reach but under the guidance of Danny McGoona reached the final of the Cookson Cup again, only to lose out 4-3 to Bethesda in one of the most dramatic finals for years.

In the 2009/10 season under the management of Barry Jones and Keith Tansley a young Conwy side finally clinched the Cookson Cup. An extra time penalty from Matty Bennett won the trophy against rivals Llandudno Junction at Maesdu. In the league the club finished sixth.

The following season Paul Moroney took over as Manager with Barry Jones and Keith Tansley remaining at the club. The 2010-11 turned out to be one of the most successful seasons of the clubs recent history. Although losing the first game of the season away at Denbigh, Moroney's side went on to win the Welsh Alliance Division One and gain promotion to the Huws Gray Cymru Alliance. Conwy also reached the final of the FAW Trophy (held at Belle Vue) where they led by two goals to nil until the 91st minute and somehow conceded three goals in as many minutes to gift Holywell Town the Trophy in one of the most dramatic finals in years. Conwy United also won the Fairplay League and young star Toby Jones picked up the top goalscorer award with a forty plus tally in all competitions which earned the youngster a move to full-time at Neath.

In the 2011/12 season, Conwy got off to a flying start in the 2nd tier of Welsh football winning their first four games under new management Steve Jones and Dean Martin. However, form dropped dramatically and in December the duo left the club. New chairman Geoff Cartwright appointed Mick McGrath as manager who signed a number of key players the team needed including Dean Canning, John Owen and Eddie Jebb (on-loan from Bangor City). The club went on to finish 10th.

In April 2012 the Football Association of Wales domestic committee approved a name change request that from the 2012/13 season the club was to be renamed Conwy Borough F.C

The club appointed Chris Herbert as the new first team manager in May 2012. The new manager re-structured the Y Morfa outfit in to a top 3 team which also lifted the league cup, when they beat Caersws on penalties in the final, with goalkeeper Terry McCormick saving 2 penalties. The win was amazingly the Tangerines 5th penalty shoot-out win in cup competitions that season.

Chris Herbert and John Keegan left their posts in December 2013 and were replaced by players Darren Moss and Aden Shannon who guided the side to a second placed finish. Moss was to remain in charge for the 2013/14 season but after a disappointing start was then released by the club in November 2014 with Shannon taking temporary charge and overseeing an 11th placed finish.

Shannon was placed in permanent charge of the Tangerines for the 2015/16 season but history was to

repeat itself when, after a poor start and with the club languishing in relegation zone, was relieved of his duties and was eventually replaced by Jason Aldcroft and former TNS defender Tommy Holmes. Aldcroft oversaw wholesale changes to the squad and steered the club to safety with an eventual 11th placed finish.

However, things did not go well for Aldcroft and Holmes in the 2016/2017 season and following some disappointing results they left the club and were replaced by Will Baxter who in turn was replaced by Brian Pritchard. Performances improved under Pritchard who took-over in November 2017 but despite some encouraging results the team was beset by injuries and bad luck and Borough were eventually relegated to the Welsh Alliance.

Prior to the start of the 2017/2018 season Brian Pritchard was replaced by Gareth "Perry" Thomas as Manager and Alun Winstanley as Assistant Manager. The 2017/2018 season was a triumph with Borough winning an historic treble after beating Rhos Aelwyd in the FAW Trophy Final at the Airfield Stadium and CPD Barmouth and Dyffryn in the Cookson Cup Final at Y Traeth but most importantly holding off a strong challenge from Llangefni to Town to seal the Welsh Alliance Title and promotion back to the Cymru Alliance.

Following an indifferent start to the 2018/2019 season there was a change of management in January 2019 with Warren Gibbs taking over as First Team Manager, eventually guiding the club to an 11th place finish in the final season of the Cymru Alliance. Manager Warren Gibbs left the club by mutual consent in February 2020 with assistant Chris Morrell taking over as Manager. However, following the departure of Gibbs Borough only played one more fixture in the inaugural season of the JD Cymru North finishing in 7th place when the season was curtailed due to Covid-19.

In the summer of 2020, Borough appointed a new management team of Matthew Jones (Manager), Stuart Howson (Assistant Manager). The 2020/21 season was cancelled due to the ongoing Covid-19 situation but the Jones and Howson led Borough to a 10th place finish in the league.

Early in the 2022/23 season Anthony Weaver took over as First Team Manager supported by James Duff as Assistant Manager and he duo will lead the team for the first time in an away fixture at Gresford Athletic FC.

Off the field, the club has made giant strides in improving the stadium and its facilities and opened its new clubhouse building "Y Morfa Venue" in the summer of 2014. With a recent upgrade to the floodlights the club has moved a step closer to achieving a domestic club license. With a thriving Junior Section and a Reserve Development Team the club looks to continue developing local talent in the future.

Past players for the club who have gone on to the Football League include; Neville Southall, Carl Dale and Kevin Ellison

# HANES Y CLWB

Er mai dim ond ers 1977 y mae'r clwb presennol wedi' ffurfi, mae nifer o dimau wedi bodoli yn y pentref yn y gorffennol. Mae tystiolaeth o dîm yn y pentref yn y 1890au yn ogystal ag amryw o dimau yn y 1920au a 30au.

Mae 'na gofnod o Port Dinorwig yn ennill Cwpan Alves Cynghrair Caernarfon a'r Cylch yn 1945/46. Roedd y timau yma i gyd yn chwarae eu gemau cartref ar gae yn Stad y Faenol.

Cyn y clwb presennol, roedd tim yn y 1960au a chwaraeodd yng Nghlyngrair Caernarfon a'r Cylch am ddau dymor. Roedd y clwb yma'n chwarae ar yr un cae a'r clwb presennol.

Ffurfiwyd y clwb presennol ar y 3ydd o Orffennaf, 1977 fel Portdinorwig Football Club, gan ymuno a Chynghrair

Caernarfon a'r Cylch. Blwyddyn yn ddiweddarach, newidiwyd enw'r clwb i Clwb Pel Droed Y Felinheli (sef yr enw sy'n cael ei ddefnyddio heddiw).

Ennillodd y clwb Cynghrair Caernarfon a'r Cylch yn 1981/82 a 1982/83, ac yn 1983/84 ymunodd y clwb a'r cynghrair newydd, Cynghrair Gwynedd. Felin oedd ennillwyr cyntaf y gynghrair yma ac yn sgil hyn, cafwyd dyrchafiad i Gynghrair Undebol y Gogledd (The North Wales Coast League). Yn 1987/88, ennillodd y clwb eu tlws mwyaf sef y 'North Wales Coast Challenge Cup', a roedd y clwb yn ail yn yr un cystadleuaeth yn 1988/89 a 1989/90.

Yn 1991/92 cyrhaeddodd y clwb eu safle uchaf erioed, sef ail yng Nghynhrair Undebol y Gogledd. Yn ogystal a hyn,

gwelwyd y dorf mwyaf erioed yn Cae Seilo pan ddaeth tua 600 o bobl i weld gem olaf y tymor yn erbyn Llangefni Town i benderfynnu tynged y gynghrair. Ennillodd y clwb Cwpan Alves y Cynghrair Undebol yn yr un tymor gan guro Nantlle Vale.

Yn 1994/95, disgynodd y clwb yn ol i Gynghrair Gwynedd, ble treuliwyd y 6 tymor nesaf. Yn ystod y cyfnod yma, roedd llwyddiant i'r clwb yn Cwpan Barrit, ac yn 2001, ennillodd y clwb Gynghrair Gwynedd a cael dyrchafiad yn ol i Gynghrair Undebol y Gogledd. Yn y tymor cyntaf yn ol, gorffennodd y clwb yn hanner uchaf y tabl, ond nid oedd y tymor canlynol mor llwyddianus a disgynodd y clwb yn ol i Gynghrair Gwynedd. Roedd disgyniad arall y tymor canlynol yn ol i Gynghrair Caernarfon a'r Cylch.

Dros y blynnyddoedd nesaf, roedd y clwb yn ail yn y tabl ar nifer o achlysuron, a ennillodd y clwb y NWCFA Junior Cup yn 2013 a 2014.

Yn 2013/14, cyflawnodd y clwb y trebl gan ennill y gynghriar, y Junior Cup a Cwpan Llun Mewn Ffram gan sicrhau

dyrchafiad yn ol i Gynghrair Gwynedd.

Ar ol cyfnod byr o ddwy flynedd yng Nghynghrair Gwynedd, dyrchafwyd y clwb yn ol i system cyngreiriau yr FAW ar ol cyflawni'r dwbl gan ennill Cynghrair Gwynedd a Cwpan Gwynedd yn nhymor 2014/15.

Chwaraeodd Felin yn Ail Adran y "Welsh Alliance gan orffen ganol y tablyn y dair tymor cyntaf, cyn llwyddo i ennill y gynghrair yn nhymor 2019/20. Mis Mawrth 2020 daeth Covid i amharu ar bawb a phopeth, a bu rhaid dod a'r peldroed i ben, gyda Felin ar frig y tabl ac yn ennill y gynghrair oherwydd canran uchaf o bwyntiau ennillwyd y gem (pts/gêm).

Dyrchafiad wedyn i gynghrair newydd "Ardal Gogledd Orllewin", a bu hen wario a gweithio yn galed er mwyn cael y cae yn Seilo i fyny i'r safonnau angenrheidiol. Ond och, ni fu chwarae peldroed o gwbwl yn 2020/21 oherwydd Covid.

O'r diwedd cychwynnodd y gynghrair newydd yn nhymor 2021/22, a llwyddodd Felin i ymdopi gyda'r safon uwch o beldroed, gan orffen yn llled eithaf cyffyrddus yn y diwedd.





# CLUB HISTORY

Although the current club was only formed in 1977, there have been many teams in the village in the past. There is evidence of a team in the village in the 1890s and various teams during the 1920s and 30s.

There's a record of Port Dinorwic winning the Caernarfon & District League Alves Cup in 1945/46. All of the above teams played their home games on a field within the Faenol Estate.

Before the current club there was a team in the 1960's that played in the Caernarfon & District League for two seasons, this club played on the same ground that the current club plays on.

The current club was formed on the 3rd of July 1977 as Portdinorwic Football Club and entered the Caernarfon

And District League. A year later the name was changed to Clwb Pel Droed Y Felinheli (which is the name that is currently used).

The club won the Caernarfon And District League in 1981/82 and 1982/83, and in 1983/84 they entered the newly formed Gwynedd League, of which they were the inaugural champions and got promoted to the Welsh Alliance League (The North Wales Coast League). In 1987/88 the club won their highest honors the North Wales Coast Challenge Cup, the club were finalist in the same competition in 1988/89 and 1989/90.

In 1991/92 the club gained their highest league position of 2nd in the Welsh Alliance League, they also had their

highest attendance of all time when approximately 600 people turned up at Cae Seilo to watch the end of season title decider against Llangefni Town. Also that season, the club were the Welsh League Alves Cup Winners against Nantlle Vale.

In 1994/95 the club were relegated back to the Gwynedd League, where the club spent the next 6 seasons. During this period the club gained success in the Barritt Cup, in 2001 the club won the Gwynedd League, gaining promotion back to the Welsh Alliance League. After a relatively successful 1st season back with a top half finish, the 2nd season was not as impressive finishing at the foot of the table being relegated to the Gwynedd League. With a further relegation the next season to the Caernarfon District League.

Over the next few years the club were runners up a few times along with back to back NWCFA Junior Cup titles in 2013 and 2014.

In 2013/14 the club achieved the coveted League, Junior Cup and Llun Mewn Ffram treble achieving

a promotion back to the Gwynedd League.


After a short two season spell in the Gwynedd League the club gained promotion back into the FAW's directly affiliated league system after winning the Gwynedd League and Cup double in the 2014/15 season.

CPD Felinheli played in the Welsh Alliance Division 2, finishing mid-table in the first three seasons, before being crowned champions in 2019/20, in a season disrupted by the Covid pandemic. No more games could be played after late March, and the league (as with all other leagues) was decided by "points per game".

Felin were promoted to the new "Ardal North West" league, but not before having to go to considerable effort and expense to bring the Seilo field up to the required standards. But no football was played in the 2020/21 season because of the pandemic.

"Ardal NW" eventually kicked off in 2021/22, and Felin coped well with the step up in standard and managed to finish 11th in the inaugural season.
